Most of our posts are in overseas primary and secondary schools that teach all or most subjects in English. With requirements that are similar to state schools at home, most of our clients require the following:

- Teacher training such as a Bachelors of Education, or a non-Education related Bachelors degree plus teacher training such as a Post Graduate Certificate in Education, or Masters of Education.
- Good, recent, verifiable teaching references and a clean criminal record check.
- Experience teaching in one of the following countries: UK, Ireland, US, Canada, Australia or New Zealand.
- Experience of teaching children for whom English is not the first language is usually helpful but a TEFL certificate is not usually required.
- Many schools prefer teachers with at least 2 years of recent, relevant experience though some will consider Newly qualified teachers and those with 1 year of post-qualification experience.





Successful international teachers must possess a combination of personal resiliency, flexibility and professional competency. Open-mindedness, both in terms of cultural sensitivity as well as open mindedness about the type of school and locations considered is also paramount. Open minded teachers who take the time to understand the culture, cost of living and lifestyle of a new location are more easily placed.

The length of experience is also a factor. A majority of schools require at least 2 years of recent, relevant post-qualification teaching experience, and some expect even more, but teach**anywhere** can help to place teachers who are newly qualified provided they are flexible in terms of location preference. Finally, because housing is often provided by the school, teachers who have dependent families or spouses must be matched to jobs that offer suitable employment packages, which can further limit choices.
